A LETTER FROM THE FINANCE COMMITTEE

Dear members and friends of Statesboro First UMC:

I am writing this letter on behalf of the Finance Committee to express our gratitude for your financial generosity. Your faithfulness in giving to the Operating Budget and to Preserving God's House, as well as your immediate response to mission needs, does not go unnoticed by the leadership of this church.

The Finance Committee also wants to give you an update on where our church stands financially at the midpoint of the year. For the first four months, our Operating Budget receipts exceeded our expenses. However, once we got into the summer months where traditionally giving goes down and expenses go up, our expenses for the year now exceed our receipts by \$50,473.93. This deficit is actually lower than in previous years and lower than the deficit that was budgeted, but we still wanted to let you know where we stand financially.

Our original line of credit of \$850,000, which was obtained to replace roofs and HVAC systems throughout our church, and sound and lighting for the sanctuary, has now been reduced to a balance of only \$267,281.40. This past month we were able to make a payment of \$25,000 to reduce the loan to its present balance.

The Preserving God's House II pledge campaign resulted in pledges of \$517,340. We are half way through this campaign, and we have remaining outstanding pledges of \$322,770.53. This is exciting as our balance on the loan is now smaller than the remaining pledges! The sooner we pay off this line of credit, the sooner we can prepare for the critical decisions that lie ahead, especially those pertaining to the growth of our ministries through possible capital expansion.

If you are in a position to pay any part of your pledge early without compromising your ability to give to the operating budget, please consider doing so. We are ahead of schedule in the area of loan repayment, but we do not want to fall behind and not be able to address the issues that could impact our growth.

We thank you in advance for your generosity.
