# METHODIST CHILDREN'S HOME SUNDAY

This Sunday, September 25, is Methodist Children's Home Sunday at Statesboro At all four worship services, you will be given an opportunity to financially give to this important ministry. The Rev. Mark Magoni, Chaplain and Vice President of Church Relations for the Methodist Home for Children and Youth, will preach at the 8:30 and 11AM Traditional Worship Services and will also lead the Dan Williams Sunday School Class.

Prior to serving at the Methodist Home, Rev. Magoni served as pastor of Wesley UMC in Macon, as Associate Pastor at St. Paul UMC in Columbus, and as pastor at Midland UMC. He received his undergraduate degree from the University of Georgia (Go Dogs!) and his Master of Divinity from Asbury Theological Seminary in Kentucky. Before becoming a United Methodist pastor, Mark spent 13 years in campus ministry and youth ministry. Beginning in the summer of 2000, he began to be very involved in ministry to orphans in Krivoy Rog, Ukraine and has made 19 trips to Ukraine. Mark's wife, Fran, is an ordained Deacon and serves as an Associate Pastor at Martha Bowman UMC in Macon. Mark and Fran have three grown daughters.
