Today we highlight the ministry of United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). We are asking you to make a special donation to assist this wonderful ministry whose purpose is to be the "feet on the ground" in every natural disaster around the world. UMCOR receives no monies from any other funds in the church and depends entirely on faithful church members for their financial support.

In 1994, I was the pastor of Leesburg United Methodist Church when Tropical Storm Alberto came our way. Through grants from UMCOR to our Conference, Jim and Hilda Dutrow (faithful members of our church) spent a year and half living in the Albany area as they organized work teams from all over the United States who came to repair and rebuild homes. Twenty-five families in the Leesburg church had major damage to their homes, and the church spent over a year helping people rebuild their homes and lives.

When an appeal is made to give money to a certain area devastated by fire, a flood, tornado or hurricane, UMCOR is able to immediately advance grant money to that area even before they have received church offerings. They are able to do that because of seed money received on UMCOR Sunday. When the offerings are received, those monies are then placed back in the UMCOR account ready to be used for the next disaster.

The offering for UMCOR also pays for the administrative expenses needed to run this operation. You may recall that when an appeal is made for a certain area, you are told that not one penny of your money is tied up in administrative expenses. We are able to do this because of generous offerings to this basic UMCOR Sunday offering. Please make your check payable to the church and designate it for UMCOR.

Wheel Chair Ramp Ministry

In past years Statesboro First United Methodist Church had an active ministry providing low cost ramps to local people that could not safely use the existing entry stairs to their home. The recipient would pay for the materials and a group of men from the Church would construct the ramp free of charge. Somehow that ministry faded away but there was still a need for this type of ministry in the Statesboro area. Recently this ministry has been revived at Statesboro First. This began last July with construction on a ramp in the Brooklet area which was a referral from the Habitat for Humanity office. A second Habitat referral was completed in December and a third was completed in March; referred from Statesboro High School. This ministry of our Church has been approved for partial funding through the United Way of Southeast Georgia for their 2019 fiscal year.
